

InfoGrund Teacher Training Program in the Digital World

In-person training November 29-30, 2025

Duration of the training: October 2025 to May 2026

Location of the two-day in-person training: Budapest

Total number of participants: 13

Number of participants from the countryside: 5

The accredited six-month teacher training program aims to prepare teachers to develop their students' awareness and filtering skills when consuming information. Embedded in a framework of critical thinking, the training program expands students' knowledge so that they can more confidently recognize false and misleading online content and recognize reliable, quality news. During the first two months of the training program, teachers acquired the knowledge necessary to teach the subject in school through an e-learning course. The aim of the weekend classroom training was to deepen the teachers' knowledge and to jointly process the e-learning course in a practice-oriented and experience-based manner. The program for the second day was to prepare for the teaching practice in the third phase of the training and to deepen methodological knowledge. In the third phase of the training, between December 2025 and May 2026, teachers will implement the teaching materials received in the programme in their own schools in grades 9-12 in 9 lessons. The teaching materials enable the development of critical media literacy in a practice-oriented, experience-based manner, built on group work.
